Ergonomic Multi-Point Locking System Auto Locking without the key -for front and back doors

The Ergonomic locking system is a easy to use locking system which does not rely on key locking. The positioning of the profile cylinder is located above the door handle instead of the below, making operation from inside or outside much easier for use by the elderly and infirm.

The Ergonomic lock is handle operated with a split follower; it can be used in both front and back door applications. The entire lock can be deadlocked from the outside by only lifting the lever upwards. This automatically locks the system and a key is necessary to open the lock and gain access to the dwelling. From the Inside, the lock can be opened easily using the handle or completely deadlocked by using the key.

Uniquely the lock mechanism has a "switch" which can convert the lock to a 'back door application' i.e. if entering the garden the handle can be still be activated from the outside to regain access to the dwelling.

- 2 Solid Steel Hooks
- Can be used with all profile cylinders that conform to DIN 18252 or EN1303
- Deadlocking of the lock by lifting the handle 45 degrees
- Anti slam function to protect against accidental damage to hooks
- Emergency escape via the lever from inside even when door is deadlocked
- 55mm or 65mm backset options
- Split follower for Lever lever or Lever pad options
- Lock Housing fully enclosed for security and weather performance.
